This program is available to social assistance recipients and people living on a low income. You will be asked to provide information about your income to determine if you are eligible.

TO APPLY:

If you are not on social assistance: Call the number for HHF above.

If you are on Ontario Works: Contact your caseworker. Ontario Works phone numbers are:

If you are on Ontario Disability Support Program: Contact your caseworker first at 1-800-267-4355 or 613-962-9562, and then call HHF.

ELIGIBLE ITEMS:

Rent Arrears

- A letter from your landlord verifying rent arrears will be required.

Hydro or Heat Deposit

- To pay a deposit.

Hydro or Heat Arrears

- If you are on social assistance contact your caseworker.
- LEAP (Low-Income Energy Assistance Program) or Winter Warmth Program.
To apply for LEAP contact your utility. Contact information can be found on your bill. In North Hastings contact United Way of Greater Simcoe County at 1-855-ITS-LEAP (1-855-487-5327). To apply for Winter Warmth (gas only) contact 613-771-9630

Health & Welfare

- Hotel accommodations due to homelessness; emergencies considered on case-by-case basis

Rent Deposit

- Possible assistance with last month's rent deposit for a new tenancy

- LEAP (Low-Income Energy Assistance Program) or Winter Warmth Program to be accessed first. To apply for LEAP contact your utility. Contact information can be found on your bill. To apply for Winter Warmth (gas only) contact 613-354-7633
