## Who we are

We are a group of Public Libraries working with legal professionals from the Community Advocacy & Legal Centre (CALC) and Community Legal Education Ontario (CLEO) to ensure that front-line Library staff have the training and resources they need to assist customers with legal questions and make referrals.

The project started in 2011 with Deseronto Public Library and Tyendinaga Township Public Library working with CALC. Soon other Libraries and CLEO joined the group. Today the Libraries in the group include Tweed, Deseronto, Quinte West, Belleville, and the Hastings County Law Association Library.

## What we do

The group works together to organize legal information training for front-line Library staff to give them the tools they need to help customers with legal questions and to make referrals to appropriate agencies.

We also share information about the best legal resources available for our collections. We distribute legal information to the public as provided by Community Advocacy & Legal Centre (CALC) and by Community Legal Education Ontario (CLEO).

In November 2011, the first Library staff training sessions were held in Belleville and in Tweed, with participation from several area Libraries. In 2012, additional training was held in Napanee. Work continues with Libraries across the region.
