If you live in Hastings, Prince Edward, or southern Lennox & Addington counties and are a low-income senior (ages 60+), CALC may be able to do your Will and Power of Attorney for free. We also have some Power of Attorney services available to individuals living on a low income under the age of 60. Please call to see if you qualify for services.

Queen's Elder Law Clinic - 613-533-2950

The Queen's Elder Law Clinic is run through Queen's Law School. If you are a senior (ages 55+) and living on a low income, a law student may be able to do your Will and Power of Attorney for free. You must be able to travel to Kingston for appointments. Call to see if you qualify for services.

Pro Bono Ontario may be able to do your Power of Attorney for free if you are living on a low income. Lawyers that assist with Powers of Attorney are available Monday to Friday mornings from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Please call to see if you qualify for services. **They do not do Wills.**
